## LGBQTIA+

"Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer (LGBTQ) Pride Month is currently celebrated each year in the month of June to honor the 1969 Stonewall Uprising in Manhattan. The Stonewall Uprising was a tipping point for the Gay Liberation Movement in the United States. In the United States the last Sunday in June was initially celebrated as 'Gay Pride Day,' but the actual day was flexible. In major cities across the nation the 'day' soon grew to encompass a month-long series of events."

## Some Numbers:

- 12% US adult population who identified as LGBTQ in 2017<sup>2</sup>
   Percentage increased as age decreased, from 5% of aged 72+ to 20% aged 18-34
   17% US college students who identify as lesbian, gay, queer, bisexual, asexual, or questioning<sup>3</sup>
   17% US adult LGBTQIA+ population aged 25+ with a bachelor degree (13% with graduate degree; degree rates 2x higher for queer men than queer women)3
- 73% US adult population who knew someone who identifies as gay or lesbian in 2017 29% knew someone who identified as bisexual, 16% transgender, 8% queer, 79
  63% US non-LGBTQ population aged 18-34 classified by GLAAD as "Allies" in 2017 Compared to 53% aged 35-51, 51% aged 52-71, and 39% aged 72+.
- 25% LGBTQ+ survey respondents who couldn't access HIV providers during the COVID-19 crisis<sup>3</sup>
- 40% LGBTQ+ youth who have considered suicide in the previous year<sup>3</sup>
